AUDITION PROCESS



OPEN CAST SUBMISSIONS

Cast submissions are now open to all performers aged 10-19 years at time of rehearsal commencement.

Performers are required to prepare and submit a 16-bar excerpt from a musical theatre song (from the selections provided), using a neutral Australian accent.

Submissions should be filmed in landscape orientation with a mid-shot framing, capturing the performer from the waist to the top of your head. Recordings can be done on a mobile phone, but make sure you can be seen and heard clearly. Following this, please upload your self-tape to YouTube or Vimeo (as 'Unlisted') and include your full name in the video description. Your performance should be recorded "live". Do not edit, mix, add effects or pitch correct your vocals.

Tips and Tricks:

- Please make sure the video is brightly lit and a mid-shot (waist up).
- Perform your audition as you would on stage it's not a singing exam, so don't concentrate solely on your voice. Use expression, and entertain us!
- Tell us a story! Articulate clearly. Think about consonants and the end of words.
- Keeping movement and gestures to a minimum, as too many gestures can distract the audition panel.
- Even though you're on camera, you need to project (voice and energy) like you are on the stage of a large theatre.

What to include in your submission email:

You will need to email the following information to casting@stageschool.com.au

- Your name and date of birth
- Your YABC, AYT or ABDA group (if currently enrolled)
- A brief outline of your performing experience
- Your accurate height, shirt size, pants/dress and shoe size
- A <u>LINK</u> to your audition video (if password protected, you must include the password). DO NOT attach the video or send a file/link that requires download.

Submissions close: Monday 1 April 2024.

IN-PERSON AUDITIONS

Selected applicants will be invited to an in-person vocal and movement audition session on Sunday 14 April 2024 at the Stage School Studios (Cnr Cameron & Allen Streets, Coburg). In-person audition material will be provided at time of invitation. Sessions are by appointment and last approximately one hour.

NB: Certain performers will be called back on Tuesday 16 April 2024 at the Stage School Studios (Cnr Cameron & Allen Streets, Coburg) to audition for principle roles, however, most positions available in the cast are for the ensemble.

Video and sound recording may be taken of auditionees during the audition process, for internal use only.

Successful auditionees will be notified via email following the final round of auditions.
